We the undersigned, members of the Australian Society for Immunology, having listened to a report by Professor B. Boettcher of the evidence related to blood on items associated with the trial of Lynn and Michael Chamberlain, and having the opportunity of inspecting a number of items relevant to the evidence and of perusing the forensic biologist's work notes and the transcript of the evidence from the second inquest and the Chamberlains' trial related to the items tested for blood, agree that - in our opinions - it should not be accepted that haemoglobin F has been adequately demonstrated to have been present on the items belonging to the Chamberlains.
