

## France and Europe EMCR Mobility Grants: information for host researchers

The France and Europe EMCR Mobility Grants support Australian early- and mid-career researchers to undertake a focused research visit in France or across Europe, working with leading researchers at major science and technology organisations.

As part of a collaboratively developed project proposal, the application requires a letter of support from the host researcher or host organisation named in the submission.

The letter of support should address the following points:

- Why the proposed project and collaboration are valuable from your perspective, including any existing or planned research links with the applicant.
- How the visit will contribute to the project activities and strengthen the collaboration between the applicant, you and your organisation.
- Why your organisation is an appropriate host location for the proposed visit, including relevant expertise, facilities, research environment or other capability.
- The contribution you or your organisation expects to make to the proposed activities, such as supervision, mentoring, technical guidance, access to facilities, collaborative analysis or development of project outputs.
- Confirmation that you and your organisation support the application, are willing and able to host the applicant for the proposed visit period, and will provide appropriate facilities, access and practical support relevant to the project.
- Any relevant relationships with the applicant, including current or previous supervisory relationships, collaborations or joint publications.

The signed letter should be prepared on institutional letterhead and sent electronically to the applicant for inclusion in the grant application.

Please provide the signed letter to the applicant with enough time for them to submit their complete application by **11.59pm (AEST) Wednesday, 16 September 2026**.
